He was born on the 8th of November 1965 in Maiduguri, Borno State. He had his Primary School Education at Mafoni Primary School, Maiduguri between 1971 -1978 and went to the Borno Teachers College in Maiduguri in 1978. He passed the Grade II Teachers Certificate in 1983 and took up appointment briefly as Audit Assistant in the Borno State Audit Department and went to the Ahmadu Bello University Zaria to read Diploma in Civil Law in 1986. In 1988, he gained admission to read Bachelor of Laws

Degree, (LL.B) at the University of Maiduguri. He was admitted to the Nigerian Law School in Lagos between 1992-1993 and called to the Nigerian Bar as Solicitor and Advocate of the Supreme Court of Nigeria on the 16th of December 1993.
